Infraction category				
<p>Offences against public order</p> <p>Sections 46–83—This category includes offences against the government, against the nation, piracy, etc.</p>				
<p>Terrorism</p> <p>Secs. 83.01–83.3—All offences related to terrorism.</p>				
<p>Firearms and Other Weapons</p> <p>Sections 84 to 117.11—This category includes arms trafficking and other weapons-related offences.</p>				
<p>Offences against the administration of justice</p> <p>Sections 118 to 144—This category includes offences against peace officers, public officials, and any other offences against the administration of justice.</p>				
<p>Sexual Offences or Offences Against Public Morals</p> <p>Sections 150–180 and 271–277. This category includes sexual offences, ranging from sexual acts to sexual assault, as well as offences against an individual's privacy.</p>				
<p>Sexual offences against a minor</p> <p>Sections 151, 152, 153, 153.1, 155, 160(3), 162, 163(1), 163(2)(a), 163.1, 168, 170, 171, 171.1(1)(a)(b)(c), 172, 172.1, 172.2(1)(a)(b)(c), 173(1), 173(2), 273.3(1)(a)(b)(c), 271(1) and 272(2)(a)(b), 273, 279.011, 273.02(2), 279.03(2), 286.1(2), 286.2 (2), 286.3 (2)—These offences are of a sexual nature, ranging from sexual acts to sexual assault, but only against people under the age of 18.</p>				
<p>Against the person and reputation</p> <p>Sections 214 to 320.101—These offences concern violence against persons, reputation, and hate speech.</p>				
<p>Means of transportation</p> <p>Secs. 320.11–320.36—These offences include, among others, impaired driving and dangerous driving.</p>				
<p>Property Offences</p> <p>Sections 321–366—These offences include, among others, theft, extortion, fraud, and trafficking in stolen property.</p>				
<p>Fraud</p> <p>Sections 379 to 426—These offences involve fraud, ranging from identity theft to forgery.</p>				
<p>Offences against property and animals</p> <p>Sections 428 to 445.1—These offences involve damage to another person's property and animal cruelty.</p>				
<p>Currency-related offences</p> <p>Sections 448 to 462—These offences involve the production and/or trafficking of counterfeit currency.</p>				
<p>Conspiracy and Aiding and Abetting</p> <p>Sections 468 to 490.1—These offences concern the attempt to commit criminal acts or to participate in them before, during, or after the commission of the offence.</p>
